Profile

Creekview Elementary serves children from preschool through fifth grade. There are thirty-two classrooms, including three all day kindergarten sections.

- Full-time Fine Arts (Art, Music, & P.E.) teachers provide instruction to all students. Each student receives 45 minutes each day in one of these subject areas. Creekview Elementary also has a librarian who provides training for students in literature, library use, research, and technology.
- Special education services are provided to meet the needs of students in an inclusive environment. Teams of special education teachers and regular education teachers serve students with identified special needs.
- Grade level tutors collaborate with teaching staff to provide interventions to students.
- A part time school psychologist is available for consultation to parents, teachers, and other school personnel. The school psychologist also identifies and assesses the learning and development of students.
- A full time nurse is available to provide medical attention to students.
- An Intervention Assistance Team (IAT) works to support students who are demonstrating academic or behavior difficulties in the classroom. Students are referred to IAT by teachers and parents at which time the IAT convenes to learn more about the child and brainstorm strategies to help support their success in the classroom. Parental involvement is essential throughout the IAT process.
- An Improvement Team (IT) in conjunction with the Building Leadership Team (BLT) identifies critical needs of the school and works with district leadership to develop research based strategies and action steps to promote student success.

- The Creekview PTO provides support to the staff to meet the daily needs of all students. PTO conducts fundraisers, provides financial support for field trips, programs, classrooms, as well as a host of other supports throughout the year.
- Creekview Elementary has two Parent Activity Coordinators (PAC) who plan four literacy activities a year involving students, parents, and the community.
- A free breakfast program is provided daily to all students.

PBS-Positive Behavior Support

PBS, Positive Behavior Support, is a broad range of systematic and individualized strategies for achieving important social and learning outcomes while preventing problem behavior. PBS's key attributes include proactivity, data-based decision making and problem-solving orientation. The "Big Ideas" of PBS include *Clear Expectations*, *Comprehensive Instruction of* expected behaviors, *Consistent Encouragement* of expected behaviors and *Correction* of behavior errors, as well as *Community Connections*.

A team of school professionals has been assembled at the school to create our school expectations and we have begun to communicate them to our students. The goal of the Creekview PBS program is to promote positive behavior amongst staff and students. Our goals and expectations center around three essential components for our students:

- Be Responsible
- Be Respectful
- Be Ready
