Profile:

Rosa Parks Elementary is located on the southwestern side of the Middletown City School District. Rosa Parks serves students in grades Pre-K-5 in a brand new spacious building with state of the art classrooms. We currently have a staff of 45 teachers, 21 K-5 regular education classes, 3 special education units, 2 sections of half day preschool and full-time Fine Arts (Art, Music, & P.E.) teachers provide instruction to students in all-day Kindergarten and 1st through 5th grades.

Along with a dedicated staff Rosa Parks offers many programs and services for our students:

*4 sections of all day Kindergarten

*3 first grade teachers that reduce class size to 22:1

*3 second grade teachers that reduce class size to 20:1

4 third grade teachers

3 fourth grade teachers

3 fifth grade teachers

*4 Reading Tutors

* Free breakfast program for all students.

An Intervention Assistance Team (IAT) works to support students who are having difficulties in the classroom. Students are referred to IAT by teachers and parents at which time the IAT convenes to learn more about the child and brainstorm strategies to help support their success in the classroom. Parental involvement is a very important piece throughout this process.

Rosa Parks Elementary has a parent activity coordinator who plans four literacy activities a year involving parents and students.
