Reading and Math Achievement Assessments “OAA State Tests”

Today our 4th and 5th graders brought home their results from the Reading and Math Achievement Assessments, which measure student progress toward the end-of-year Ohio Academic Standards. The standards describe what your child should know and be able to do by the end of each grade. The reports sent home will explain what the test scores mean.

Terra Nova Results

Today our 2nd and 3rd graders brought home their Terra Nova results. The report describes achievement in terms of National Percentiles, which compare your child with other students of the same grade nationally. The report may be used to determine areas of strengths and need.
