



# MHS Junior Checklist

Middletown High School Guidance Office would like to assist students and families on the college application process. Please follow the steps below as a helpful transition from junior to senior year.

## WHERE TO START?

- **Maintain Grades:**
  - Colleges & Scholarships will see Freshman-->Jr year on transcripts
- **College Prep:** Make a list of 5-10 schools (Public & Private)
  - Settle on college major & career path
- **Attend College & Career Fairs** to help finalize college list for application process
- **Schedule & Take ACT & SAT Tests**
  - ACT starting February of Junior Yr.
  - SAT starting Fall of Senior Yr.
- **Use ACT & SAT online test prep & with the ACT/SAT App**
  - FYI-See your Counselor for Fee Waivers when you are ready to register for tests

- **Continue School & Community Service Activities** (\***Hint:** keep a log for pathway graduation requirements)

## SUMMER PREPARATIONS:

- **Start your Common Application** or request college applications online
  - This will begin the college & scholarship essay process
- **Go on official college visits**
  - this will help narrow choices before the fall college application process
- **Student Athletes:** Check with Coaches & Athletic Department about NCAA requirements
- **Register for the Remind App** to stay up to date with College & Scholarship Information from the counseling office. To get connected (Text: @middies20 To: (513) 453-4171)\*sign up information on back\*
