6 CAREER FIELDS

The career fields are the six large groups. They include all of the occupations in the United States, and their titles tell you something about the focus of work in that group of occupations.

16 NATIONAL CAREER CLUSTERS

Each of the six career fields is divided into 1-4 sub-groups, called clusters. Each cluster is made up of a number of occupations and post-secondary majors related to the specialty of that cluster.

PATHWAYS

Each cluster is broken down into pathways. A pathway is made up of a group of occupations that focus on a specialty within a cluster. There are 79 pathways.
